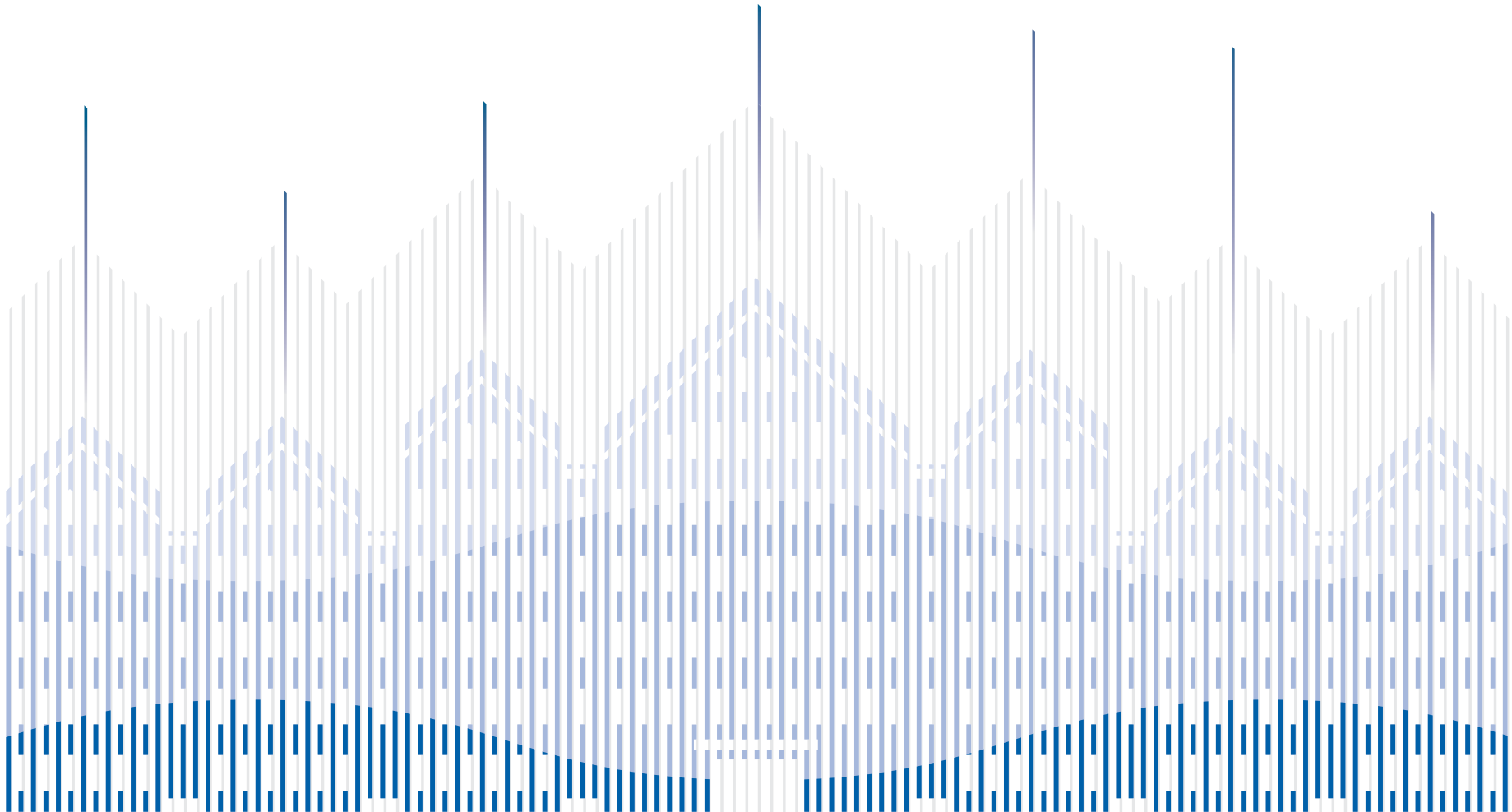

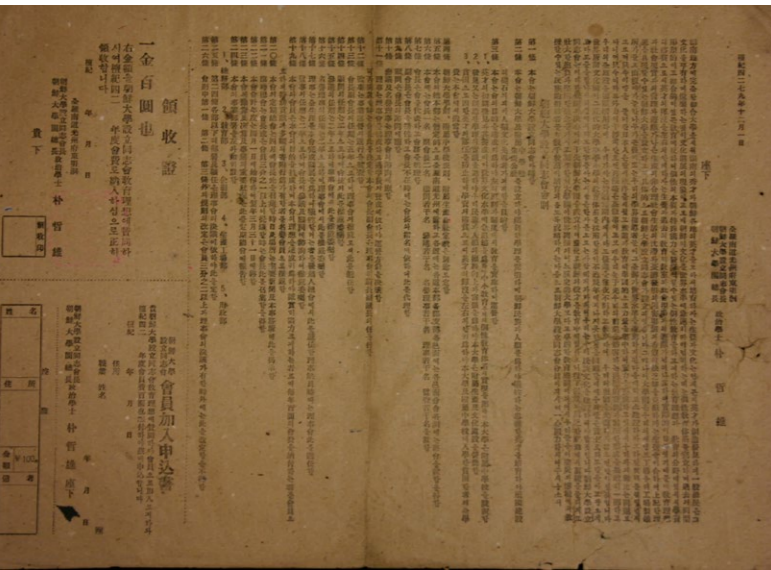

Spirit of Establishment

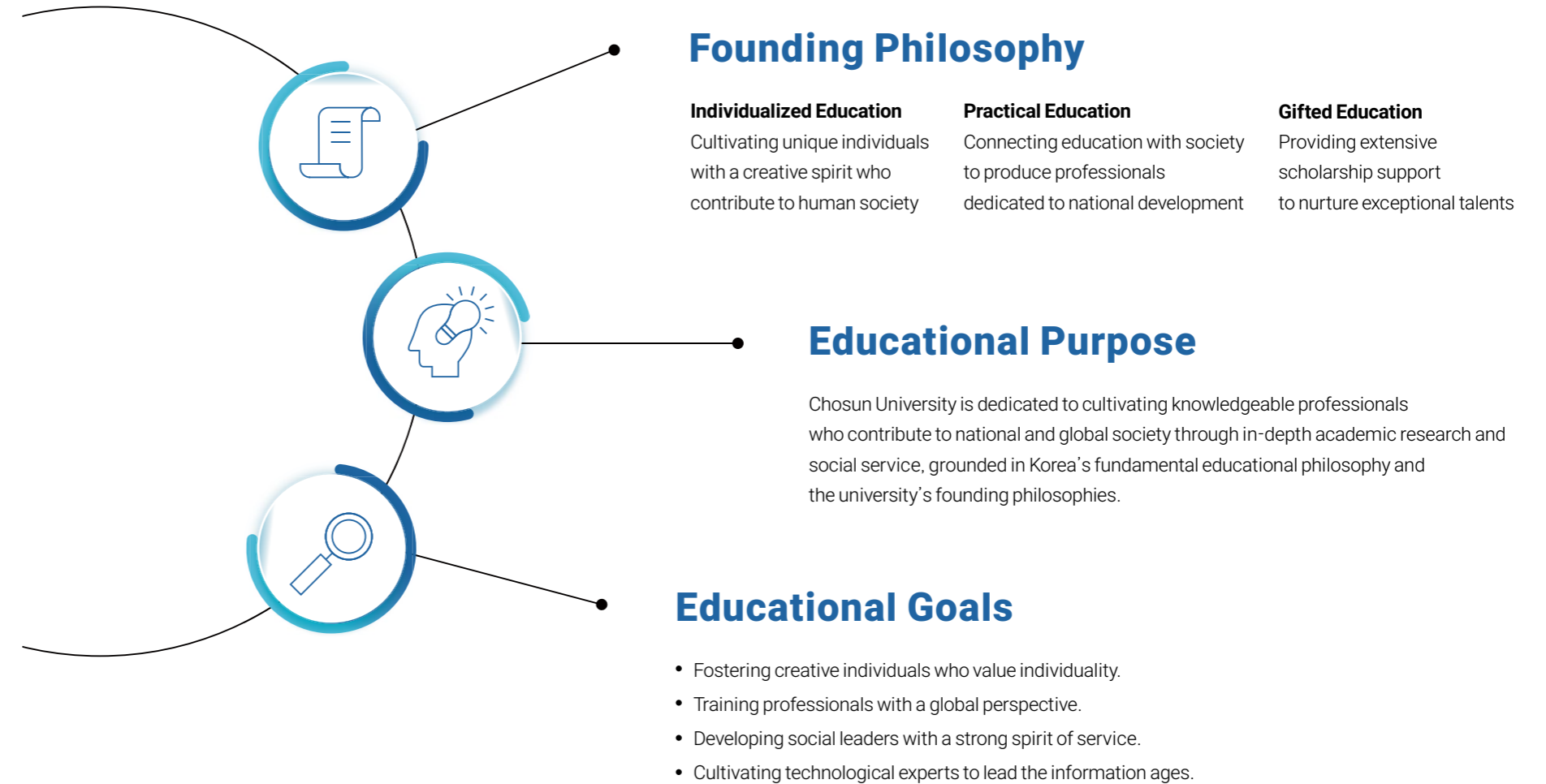
Chosun University **aspire to establish a comprehensive university in the Honam region** ... We seek to go beyond the standardized and uniform education of the past by fostering **Individualized Education**, which allows students to fully develop their unique qualities and talents ... Received approval for Chosun College Foundation, Reorganized into a 4-year university



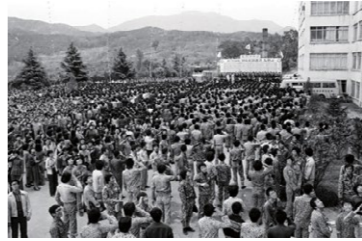

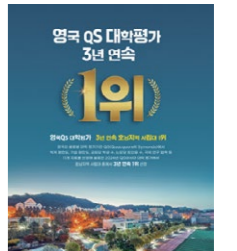

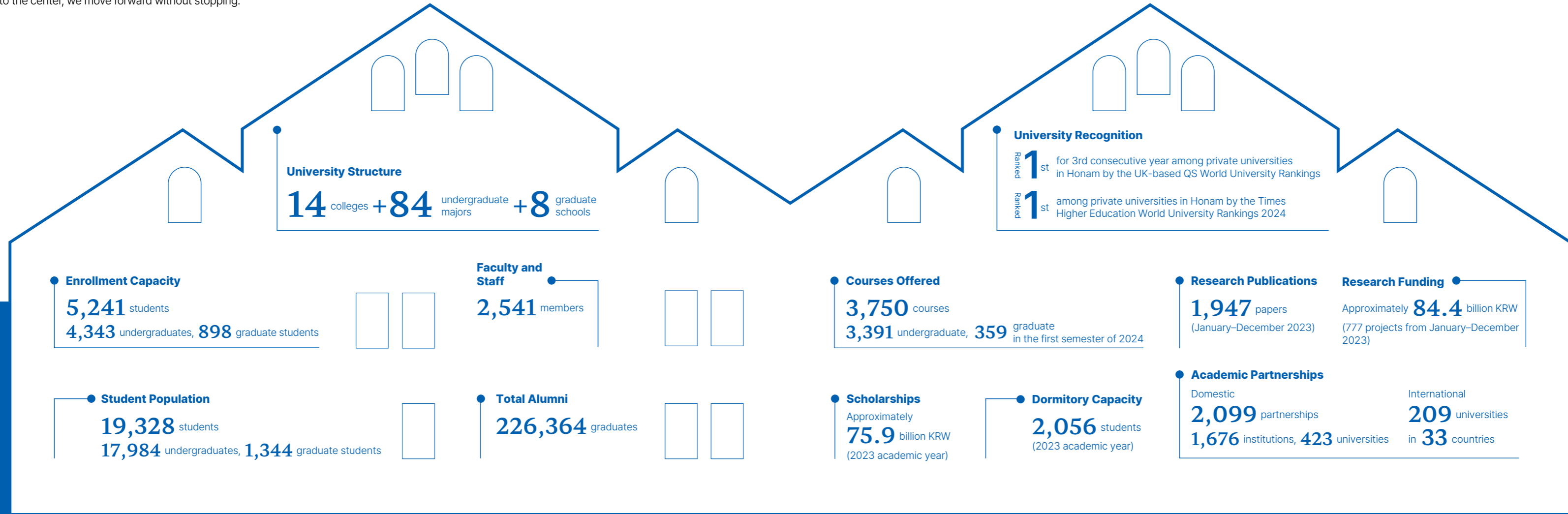

BIO AND HEALTHCARE

Leading the Future Bio-Industry through Research of Senile Disease, Core Technology Development, and Commercialization of Geriatric Diseases

- Aiming to reduce dementia prevalence by 30% through early diagnosis and predictive technology.
- Expanding the foundation for a high-value medical industry by securing Asia's largest dementia high-risk cohort and obtaining 720 billion KRW in national research funding across 16 projects over 12 years.

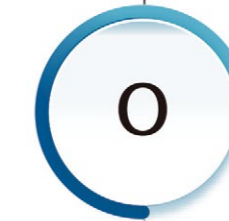
Senile Brain Disease Demonstration Research Group

- 2014** - Opened the Dementia Prevention and Management Center and established the National Dementia Research Group.
- Selected for the National Brain Science Core Technology Development Project (Dementia Brain Map Construction Project).
- 2018** - Recognized in the "Top 10 Science and Technology News of the Year" for advancements in dementia prediction, including the development of the Korean Standard Brain Map.
- 2019** - Renamed as the Gwangju Dementia Cohort Research Group.
- Established a collaborative research center with the Korea Brain Research Institute.
 - Launched a project with the U.S. National Institutes of Health (NIH) to identify dementia-causing genetic factors.
- 2021** - Initiated the Dementia Demonstration Infrastructure Project.
- Conducted a longitudinal study on dementia and cognitive impairment in the elderly (in collaboration with the Korea Disease Control and Prevention Agency).
- 2022** - Established the Asian Dementia Research Foundation.
- 2024** - Hosted the 7th NeuroScience Forum on Alzheimer's Disease (NFAD).
- Successfully developed a fluorescent material for measuring dementia-inducing toxic proteins.
 - **Began the world's first development of a medical AI system for early prediction and prevention of geriatric dementia.**



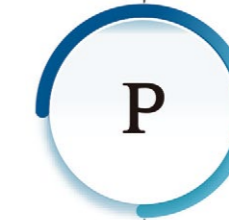

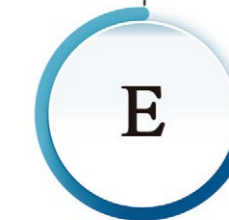

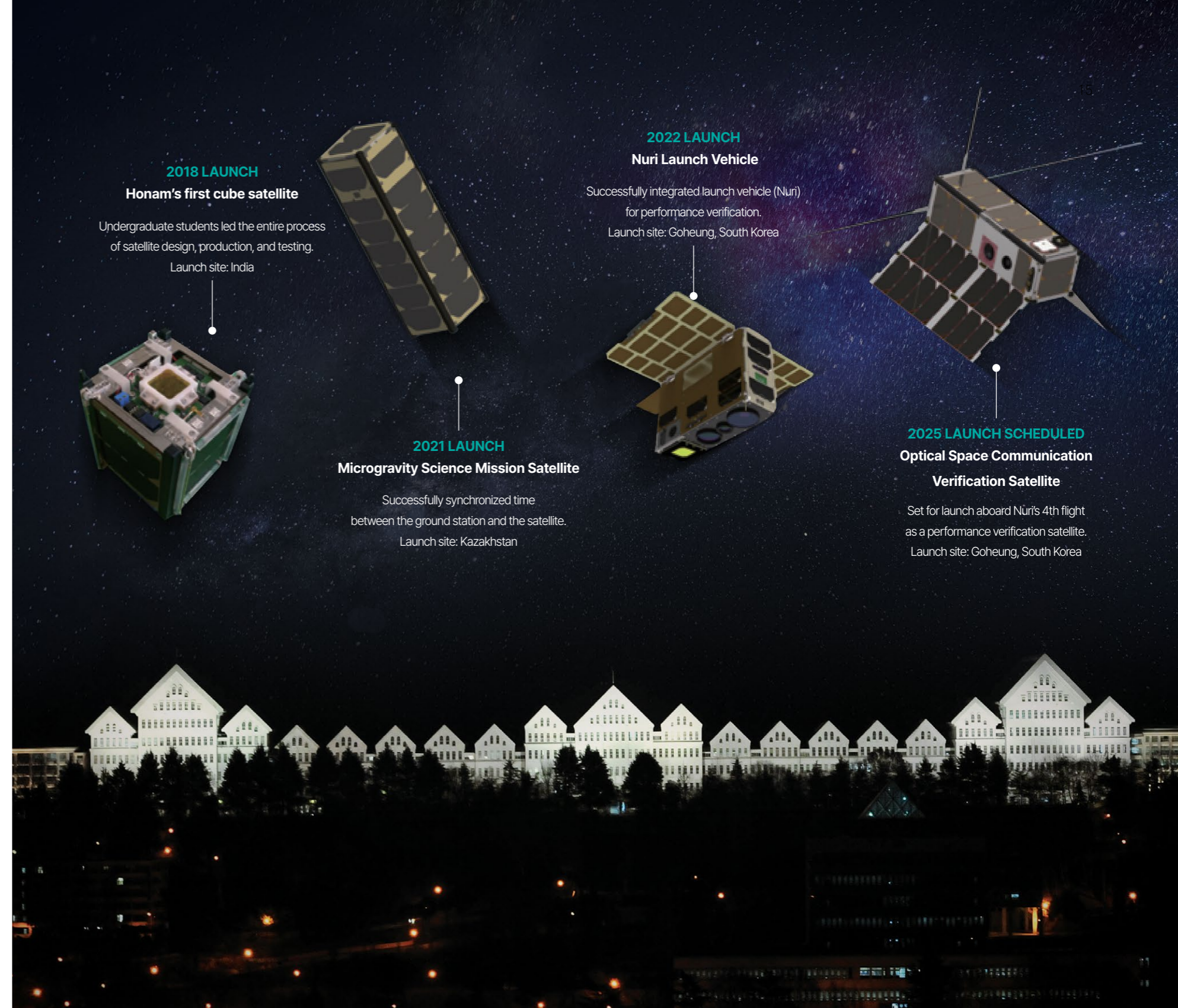

Chosun University is Paving the Way for South Korea's Entry into the World's Top 7 Space Powers!

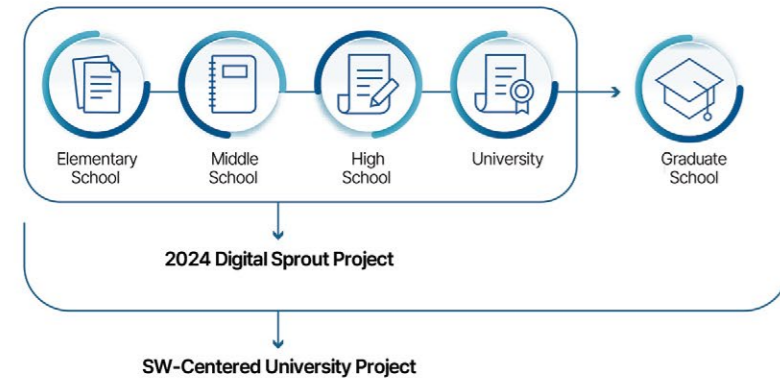
- 2018** - Developed Honam's first cube satellite, "STEP Cube Lab", and launched it from India.
- 2019** - Selected as the only regional university finalist in the cube satellite Competition for developing the ultra-small satellite "STEP Cube Lab-II".
- 2020** - Developed "STEP Cube Lab-II", a satellite designed to monitor early signs of a Baekdu Mountain eruption.
- 2021** - Conducted a cube satellite launch experiment with tardigrades (water bears) as part of the KMSL (Korea Microgravity Science Lab) project with Yonsei University.
- Conducted environmental testing on "STEP Cube Lab-II".
- Developed and successfully exported South Korea's first satellite vibration damping device to Germany.
- 2022** - Successfully deployed a cube satellite from South Korea's first launch vehicle, Nuri, during its verification satellite mission.
- The KMSL team won the Minister of Science and ICT Award at the 4th Korea Aerospace Research Institute CubeSat Competition.
- 2023** - Established the Space Technology Research Lab (SPACE LAB), becoming the third university in South Korea (after Seoul National University and KAIST) to do so.
- 2024** - Selected for the 2024 Advanced Industry Talent Bootcamp in the aerospace sector.
- 2025 (SCHEDULED)** - A high-performance cube satellite is set to be launched aboard the 4th Nuri launch vehicle in May, for orbital verification of space optical communication.



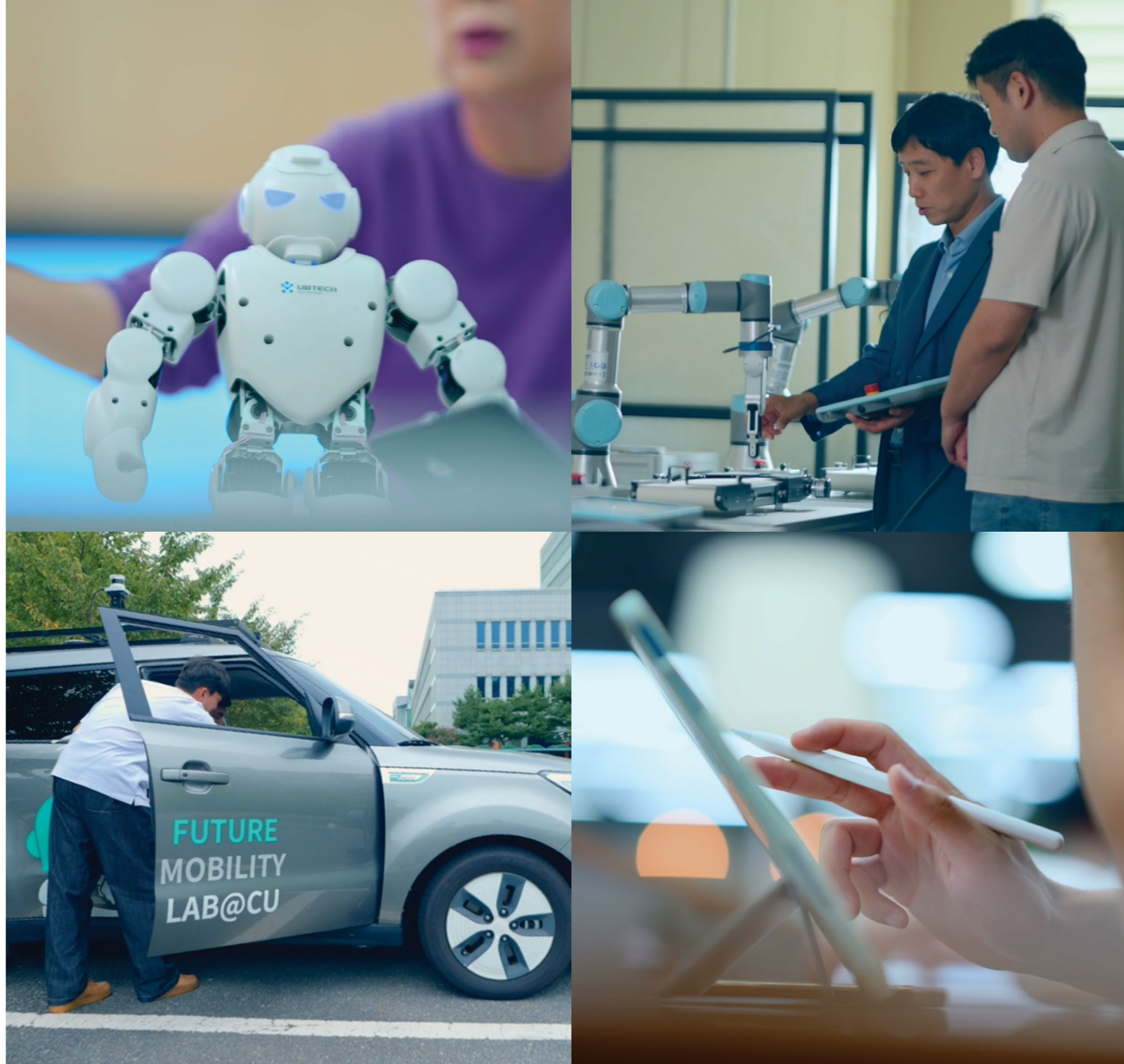
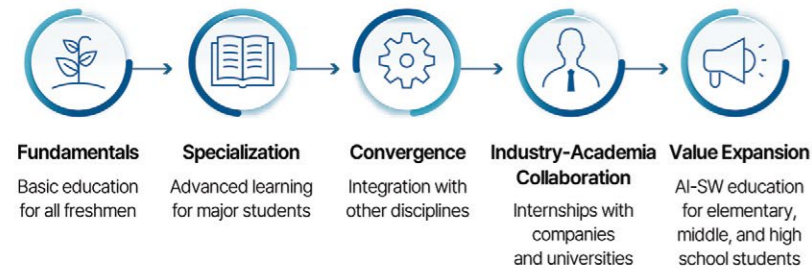

International Taekwondo Academy

- Annually hosts over 200-250 Taekwondo trainees and instructors from more than 13 countries
- Enhances overseas employment rates through international internship programs
- Contributes to the economic revitalization of the Gwangju region

Humanities Korea Plus (HK+) Project

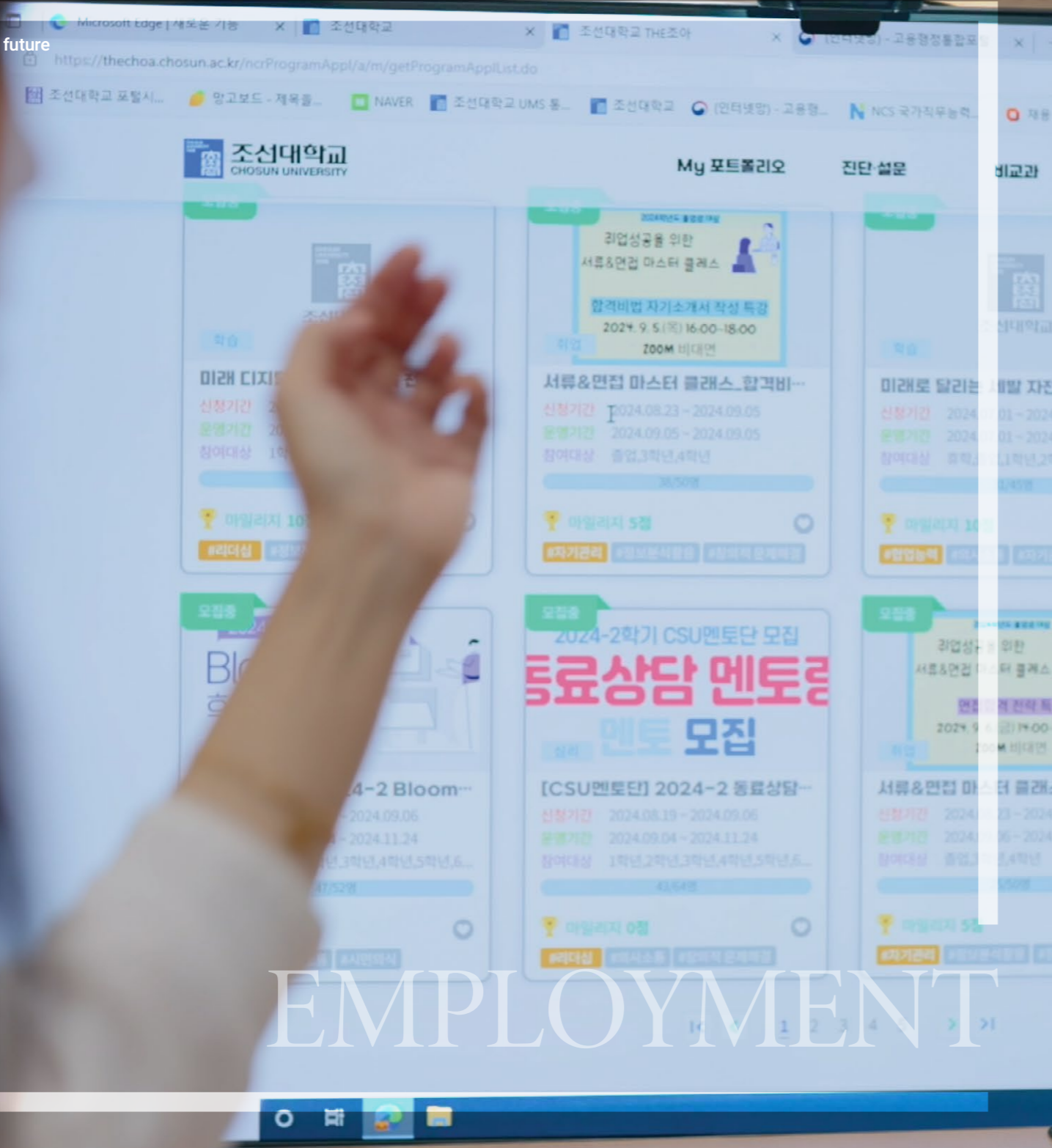
- Pioneering the field of 'Disaster Humanities', analyzing narratives of disasters and studying recovery and healing processes
- During Phase 1 (2019-2021) and Phase 2 (2022-2025), a total of 29 volumes of the Disaster Humanities Research Series were published, along with 58 academic papers. Additionally, more than 100 humanities lectures were hosted



CSU Star Artist Development Project (START II)

- A specialized education program supporting aspiring artists (undergraduate & graduate students) to become Star Artists
- Since 2023, 169 aspiring artists have participated
- Approximately 87% of participants won awards at major art competitions such as Gwangju Metropolitan Exhibition, Mudeung Art Exhibition, Suncheon Exhibition, and Eodeung Art Festival

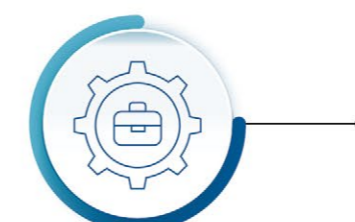

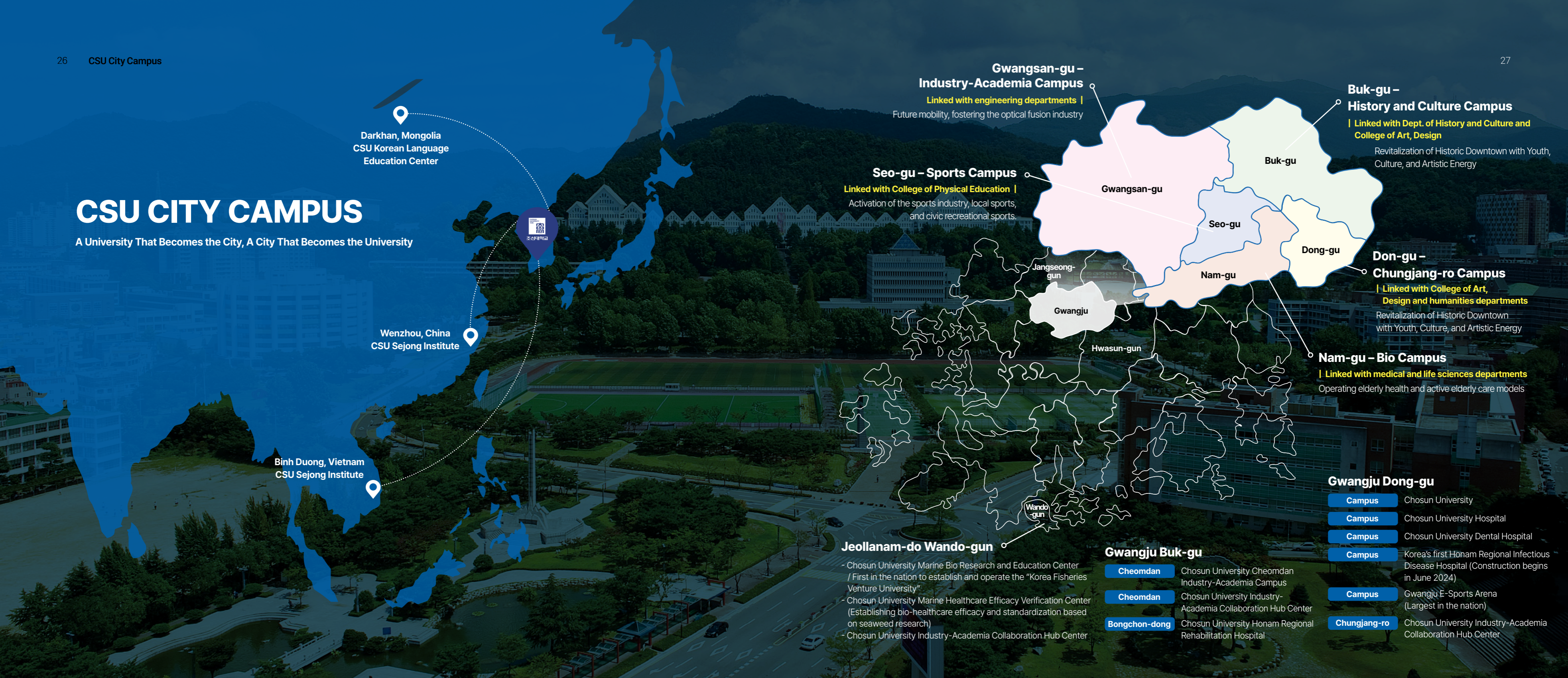
